

Kernersville, N.C. – 5 teams engaged in the 2024 Fall Red, White, and Blue Softball season. All teams faced-off a plethora of times this season against each other, all in hopes to win the regular season and post-season double-elimination tournament. Matches were hosted at the Ivey Redmon Sports Complex in Kernersville.

The season was a toss-up week-in and week-out of who could win. The hot hand started out for Choice Tire & Automotive, as they won their first 4 games of the season. They slipped and lost their first game of the season on September 23rd against the Twin City Bruisers. Choice Tire, led by Zach Ransom, found their way back in the winning circle again after winning both games in a double header the following week.

The "Mr. Consistent" team of the year goes to Twin City Bruisers, as they never went more than 1 game above or below .500 on the season. However, they managed impressive wins against DRT, Choice Tire, and Triad Church. Twin City, managed by Sonny Marroquin, put up an astounding 29 runs in the first game of the season.

Triad Church, a new team to the league, had their best game of the year against Choice Tire early in the season. Administrated by Sean Sloat, Triad put up 12 runs against their opponent. Even though they fell short of victory in the game, they showed flashes of great hitting ability.

Brian Pettus, team captain for team Mojo, had a substantial amount of success throughout the course of the year. Mojo only fell in the loss column once in the first game of the season. After, they rattled off 9 wins in a row to finish 1st in seeding headed into post-season play.

Team DRT also managed to find some success during the season. On September 9th, they matched the season high total runs scored with 29. DRT, showcased by Jeff Henighan, put themselves in good position to win throughout the span of the season, putting up 17 runs in a win against Twin City, and 12 runs a piece in a double header matchup.

The start of the double-elimination tournament did not disappoint. An upset put Choice Tire in the lower bracket, as they were bested by Twin City in a close 12 to 11 matchup. Triad Church then put up their season high 19 runs against Choice tire, but it wasn't enough as Choice Tire won by 5 runs.

Twin City continued to impress as they topped Mojo in the Semi-Final round. DRT lost a close matchup to Mojo in the first round, as that game also finished with a 12 to 11 score. Choice Tire had their work cut out for them in the lower bracket again, as DRT put up 20 runs, and Mojo put up 18. Choice Tire didn't blink, and won both games.

In the end, it was Twin City, the third ranked team to win it all. It came down to the final inning of the championship game, as Twin City won 18 to 17 against Choice Tire.



2024 Fall Kernersville Parks and Recreation Independent League Softball Post-Season Write-Up

Kernersville, N.C. – The 2024 Fall Independent League did not disappoint when it came to close matches and down-to-the-wire action. The Independent League showcased 5 teams, all competing against each other in multiple showdowns to take the top spot in regular season and in post-season play. All games were hosted at the Ivey Redmon Sports Complex in Kernersville.

In regular season play, *Century Park Tavern*, captained by Joran Shipley, made a strong case as to why they should be the #1 seed. *Century Park* started off with a 4-1 record, only falling to *Triad Auto Works* in a 14-13 game. *Century Park* continued their reign as they won 3 out of their last 4 games in the regular season.

Stay Alert Safety Services tabbed a few key wins throughout the year. Administrated by Ben Babcock, Stay Alert found themselves winning a big matchup against *Krusty Krew* late in the season in a 18-13 game. Stay Alert also bested the *Hubergroup Inkies* twice in the regular season.

The wildcard team of the season goes to *Krusty Krew*, steered by Blake Winebarger, as they captured 3 wins in 4 games during the back half of the season. On October 2nd, they were in a low-scoring, defensive game against *Stay Alert. Krusty Krew* topped their opponent by 1 run, 6 to 5, to keep themselves in the contention for the #1 seed.

Team *Hubergroup Inkies* exchanged blows with teams heavily, especially in the back half of the year. On the last night of the regular season, they put up an impressive 20 runs. Led by Seth Horniak, the *Inkies* hung around in many of their games, but ended up falling short against their competition.

Triad Auto Works, ushered by Zach Ransom, made little mistakes throughout the year. *Triad Auto* dominated throughout, only falling in one game to *Century Park Tavern* during the last game of the regular season. Their 9-1 record placed them at the top of the totem pole heading into post-season play.

Century Park Tavern stumbled early in the tournament, losing their first-round game against *Krusty Krew* 19 to 15. They quickly found their footing and went on a 3-win-run to stay alive in the doubleelimination tournament. Both the *Inkies* and *Stay Alert* competed well, but *Century Park* was too much for either team. *Century Park* eventually lost in the championship game.

Triad Auto's commanding performance didn't stop in post-season play, as they were the eventual champions, tabbing "top-dog" notches in both regular season and tournament play. Knocking *off Krusty Krew* in the semi-finals, they just needed one win in the championship series to win the tournament. They found their win in a close 25 to 20 game against *Century Park*.

Kernersville, N.C. – Kernersville Parks and Recreation opened it's 2024 Fall Coed Softball season on August 22nd. The Coed season included four teams that squared off in multiple matchups throughout the season, all being hosted at the Ivey Redmon Sports Complex in Kernersville.

Two teams battled for the top spot throughout the year, AWC and Caught Looking. Both squads started off hot, and that did not slow down as the season progressed. Caught Looking and AWC had a great matchup early on in the season, where Caught Looking, led by team captain Sonny Marroquin, bested AWC 12 to 10.
