Matches were hosted at the Ivey Redmon Sports Complex in Kernersville.

In a season defined by unpredictable weather and several uncontrollable challenges, we're proud to say the 2025 Adult Softball League has officially concluded. Despite schedule adjustments and mid-season pivots, every team showed resilience, sportsmanship, and commitment throughout the ups and downs of the summer.

The regular season was highly competitive from the start, with tight standings and weekly shake-ups in the rankings. MOJO, the #4 seed heading into the tournament, turned heads by embarking on a stunning undefeated run. The statement wins came early, in a high-scoring 19-18 thriller over top-seeded Twin City—a game that went down to the wire and set the tone for their playoff charge. Riding a wave of momentum, sharp defense, and clutch hitting, MOJO completed their Cinderella run by defeating DRT in the Championship Game, capturing the league title in remarkable fashion.

## 2025 Fall Kernersville Parks and Recreation Independent League Post-Season Write-up

**Kernersville, N.C.** – The 2025 season of the Men’s Softball League has officially wrapped, closing the book on one of the most weather-challenged and unpredictable seasons in recent memory. From the first week, the season was shaped by reschedules, rainouts, and a variety of unforeseen circumstances. Despite it all, every team showed up with energy, adaptability, and a love for the game that carried the league through a wild and competitive year.

The regular season delivered tight races and strong rivalries, with the top of the standings decided by the slimmest of margins. 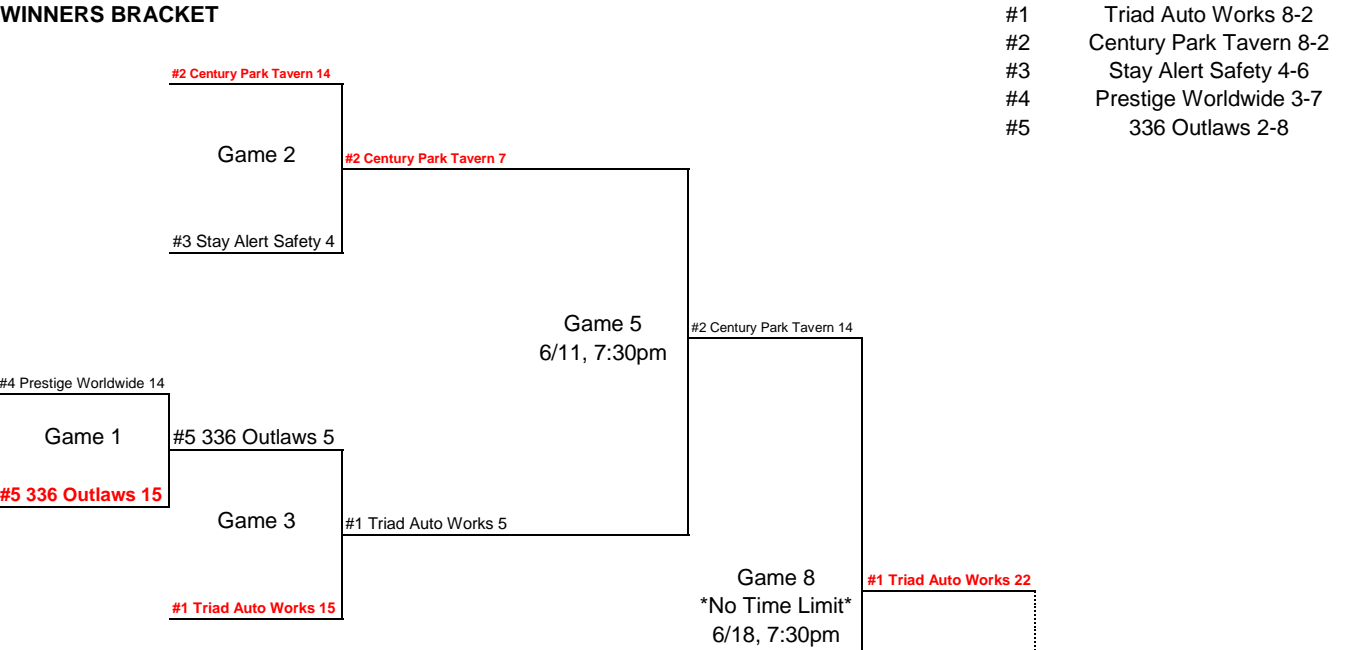
