



2026 Winter Kernersville Parks and Recreation Post-Season Write-Up Adult Volleyball Advanced League

Kernersville, N.C. – Kernersville Parks and Recreation tipped off its first Adult Volleyball season of 2026 shortly after the New Year, featuring two competitive divisions — Intermediate and Advanced — with six teams in each. While players were split across teams, they were united by one common goal: capturing the championship trophy. The 10-game regular season, followed by an intense double-elimination tournament, proved that this season truly was anyone's for the taking.

In the Advanced league, the season started off strong for Wanna Sub?, who tallied three wins in their first four games. Rob Brown, captain of Sub, found his team in a tough spot after dropping three games in a row midway through the season. They bounced back by defeating the Caniacs and Poundtown on the last night of the regular season.

Caniacs, led by Cheyenne DeBruin, found traction late in the season, knocking off Poundtown and Rush Hour in back-to-back games. DeBruin and bunch lost to Rush Hour earlier in the season, but found themselves in a close battle the second time around. This game went to three sets, and Canics bested Rush Hour 15 to 11 in a nailbiter of a last set.

Tien Pham, leader of Rush Hour, led his team to middle-of-the-season victory against the Caniacs. This close matchup resulted in the game going to three sets, where Pham and crew knocked off the Canes 15 points to 8 in the final set. They also played well against Poundtown throughout the year, falling just short in both their matchups.

Poundtown took a tough early season loss to the Concrete Crows. Taking the Crows to three sets, Dustin Rhodes, champion of Poundtown, found his crew fighting back hard but it wasn't enough. This loss did not deter their confidence, as they collected back-to-back wins the following week to find themselves back in the hunt for first place in the advanced league.

The top two place teams were the Concrete Crows and the Lousy Tippers, both returning teams from last season. Nhat K, captain of the Crows, and Kyle Bohn, bannerman of the Tippers, found themselves both 3-0 going into their first matchup of the season. The Tippers bested the Crows in two close sets. The same result happened on the last night of the regular season, where Tippers found themselves with a flawless 10-0 record. Crows knocked off every other opponent, finishing with an impressive 8-2 record.

All teams made the post-season tournament. A Gold, Silver, Bronze split between the two leagues allowed for stiffer competition in the bracket.

While players were split across teams, they were united by one common goal: capturing the championship trophy. The 10-game regular season, followed by an intense double-elimination tournament, proved that this season truly was anyone's for the taking.

Over in the Intermediate league, a mix of renewed rivalries and new teams carved the path for this season. Returning team Servivors, formerly known as 6-pack, took a tumble early in the season after starting off 1-4. Daniel Pessoa, coach of Servivors, and squad did not lose another game after that. They rattled off five wins in a row to finish the regular season at 6-4.

Two other returning teams include the Net-Flix Originals and The Maverick Ralliers. Net-flix, previously known as the Block Party Crashers, picked up a big win in the middle of the season over newcomers Bad Vibes Resistance. Bad Vibes had knocked off Net-flix in week one of the season, but couldn't hang the second time around as Vicky Musumeci, captain of Net-flix, led the way by scoring several of points in the final set.

The Maverick Ralliers played well in several matches across the season. They took Net-flix to three sets in both of their games against each other. She has served as captain since the 1st season of the league, dating back to summer 2025.

Stan Duggins and Mia Fresnia carved the path to 1st place for Hips, as they scorched their opponents in all but one game this season. They won eight-in-a-row to start the season. Hayleigh Robertson, commander of Servin', helped lead her team to 2nd place in the Intermediate league, just a game behind 1st place.
